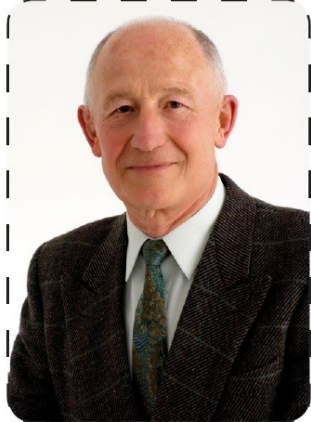

Parents: we encourage you to attend - art program for school-age children and child care for under school age children – limited places, book early.

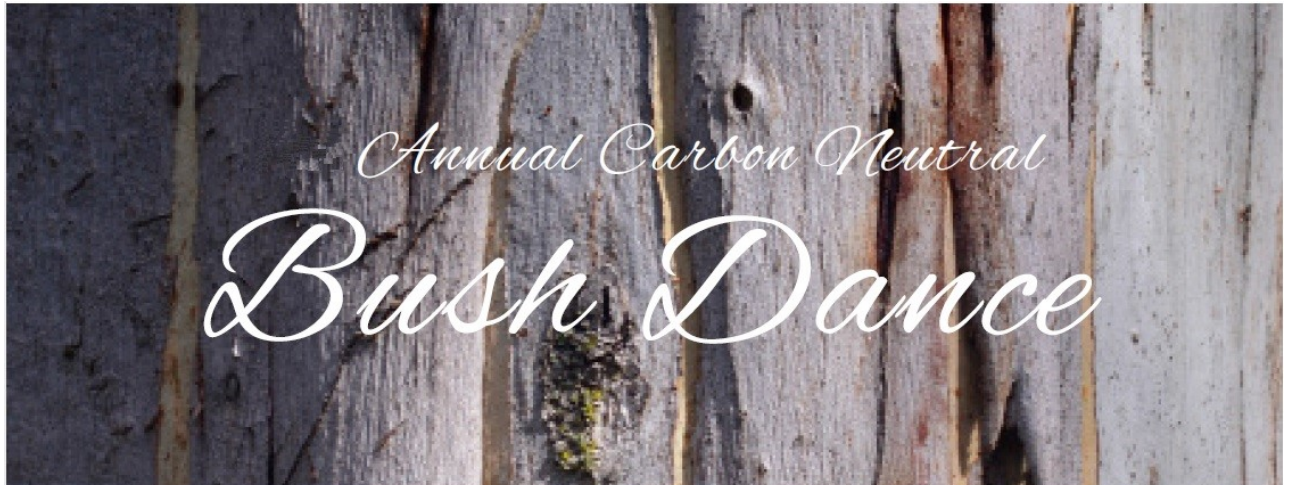

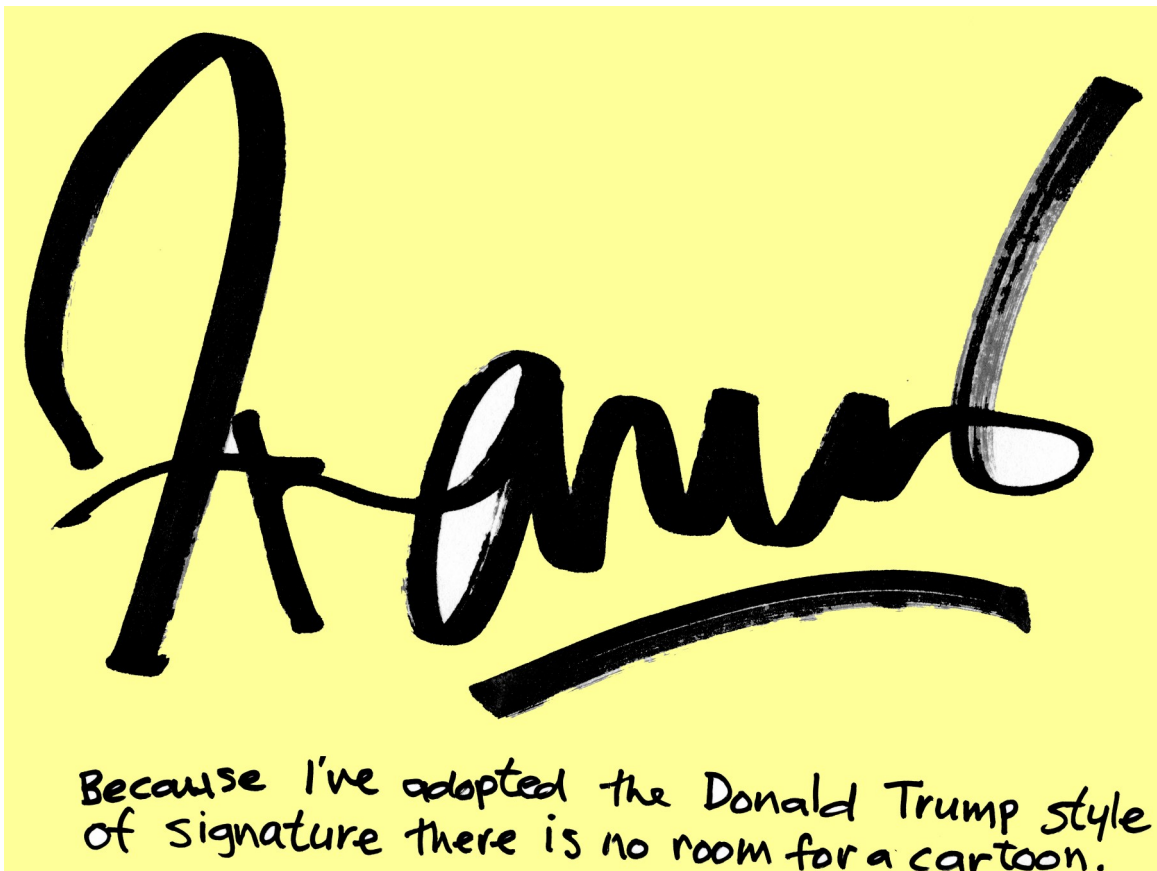
