In 2015 43 varieties were available for tasting, almost double that presented at the inaugural taste off in 2014. Last year's winner was Green Grape, closely followed by Green Zebra. #### The Monty Sugar Glider project continues to fly.

On Tuesday the second of February 8 of us gathered in Pecks Dam Reserve with Mark from Treetec to practise climbing ladders and abseiling down a tree in harnesses. We were a motivated bunch and required minimal encouragement to climb up 6 metres and more. After a full day and a written test we were qualified as being able to do basic tree access with ladder harness and lifelines.

We are now able to revisit the 30 boxes in our reserves installed a year ago and see who has moved in.

A further 70 boxes have been installed by local residents. Our tree climbers are willing to assist with their monitoring as well. If you would like some help contact us on montysugargliders@gmail.com.

We know the gliders appreciate our offer of a homes by the glider sightings reported. To date 5 households have reported seeing between 2 and 5 gliders in their garden. This is a great response when there were no sightings for 10 years prior. We will keep you posted.
